Guidance notes for applications from groups and organisations

PLEASE READ THESE GUIDANCE NOTES CAREFULLY BEFORE COMPLETING THE APPLICATION FORM.

What can you apply for?

The Nicholson Memorial Fund can provide grants to charities and charitable organisations that operate in Leicester, Leicestershire and Rutland.

Grants can be awarded for projects that assist children and young people who are delinquent, deprived, neglected or in need of care.

Please note that priority will be given to applications for specific projects or items, rather than contributions to general running costs.

Most grants awarded by this Fund are less than £500.

What is not eligible?

Applicants should be mindful that the trustees cannot by law (under the terms of our charity's governing document) fund groups that are not wholly charitable in their purpose. Grants can only be made to voluntary bodies that are either registered charities or are charitable in their objectives.

Due to the large number of applications the Nicholson Memorial Fund receives and its limited resources, the following restrictions on grant making have been agreed:

- (1) The trustees are not able to help with capital expenditure for building work and renovations.
- (2) The trustees are only able to help organisations which operate wholly or largely in Leicester, Leicestershire or Rutland.
- (3) Only one grant can be awarded to any group or organisation in a two year period.

How to apply

- A completed application form. (The application form is attached to these guidance notes.)
- A copy of your organisation's most recent year end accounts.
- Your organisation's governing document, if you are not a registered charity.
- Any supporting documentation you would like the trustees to consider.*

* In most applications this is not required, but should you wish to include supporting documents please keep these to a minimum.

Failure to complete the application form in full or to include your accounts will inevitably delay your application.
